iDwala was contracted to construct two netball courts for North Wangaratta Football Netball Club, in the North Wangaratta Recreation Reserve by the Rural City of Wangaratta. The project was part of a \$695,000 redevelopment of the recreation reserve. The development included new lighting, shelter and fencing. iDwala was able to provide excellent suggestions within the budget set by Council, which is always great for the community and organisation.

The project was partly funded by the Australian Federal Government Sport Australia funding program and saw the construction of one new Netball Victoria compliant competition courts, new player shelters and even a lighting upgrade to the adjacent AFL field. Due to budget constraints, Council chose to keep one court as asphalt.

North Wangaratta Football Netball Club now has two new Netball VIC compliant courts, an acrylic all-weather competition court and an asphalt court for practice. iDwala assisted with the design for the asphalt court to make sure the court was compliant to current requirements for competition courts.

The club was thrilled with the outcome and could not wait to get out on their new competition and practice court and experience their new competition level, LED lighting at the facility.
